MS. GANSLE: This public hearing is being held by order of the Town Board to hear all persons in relation to the Lupe Way Subdivision Sewer Improvement Project# 2017-005. An engineer's report was prepared by MJ Engineering and has been on file in the Town Clerk's office. Notice of this public hearing has been published in the official Town newspaper which is the Spotlight and has been posted in the Town Clerk's bulletin board. I have an affidavit for each. The Town Board will now hear all persons interested in this project.

MS. PECK: The proposed project is to extend municipal sanitary sewer service to 40 residential lots on 56.7 acres located at 8 Lupe Way. The municipal sewer system will connect to an existing gravity sewer system on the Morocco Lane and Lupe Way, which will provide a public sewer. The new lots will be serviced by an in gravity sewer which will connect to the existing infrastructure. The total project cost for this project is \$141,546 which again will be paid for entirely by the developer.

The 2019 permit fee for residential sewer connection is \$240 with an annual usage fee for a typical residential home being \$276.37 which is billed to the homeowner on the January bill. Thank you.
