1 SUPERVISOR MAHAN: Does anyone have any public 2 comment? Ed Greeson, 11 Beachwood. 3 MR. GREESON: Again, it's a Groundhog Day situation at Mill Road. 4 5 There redesigning this and redesigning that. The whole proposal to evaluate the land-use was to protect the 6 7 neighborhood from commercial infringement. The traffic is going to be horrible there. It's horrible already. It 8 9 can't get any better. With a very short stroke of a pen, you people put a 10 moratorium on motels on Central Avenue. At least this 11 Mill Road section needs to be investigated further. 12 13 There is nothing good that's going to come of it. This is the same auto dealer that promised that we have 14

special vehicles. Yet, they unload in the middle of Central Avenue at their dealership.

I'm just asking for common sense, please. Slow it down. We don't want Mill Road and Route 7 to be Central Avenue. That's all.

With the amount of people to come to these meetings, we get what we deserve. Thank you very much.

SUPERVISOR MAHAN: Thank you, Ed.
