assigning outside counsel and the other one was electing
to pay.

MR. MAGGUILLI: During the Agenda Session two
matters were discussed in Executive Session. One matter

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matters were discussed in Executive Session. One matter had to do with a lawsuit that was recently filed against the Justice Department and our Court Clerk Mary Falace by the County of Albany and specifically the Public Defender's office. Because the Town Attorney's office prosecutes cases in Town Court and we appear routinely in front of the Town Judges who are a part of this lawsuit as the head of the Department of Justice for the Town, my office has a conflict of interest and during Executive Session I explain the conflict in detail and requested that the Town Board give me authorization to appoint one of our outside counsel to represent the Judges in this case and Mary Falace. At this time, I would ask for a vote either approving or not approving my request for outside counsel's appointment.

MR. GREEN: I make a motion for Mike to make that appointment.

MS. MURPHY: Second.

SUPERVISOR MAHAN: Supervisor votes aye. Clerk, call the roll.

(The roll was called.)

MS. GANSLE: The ayes have it, Madam

Supervisor.

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MR. MAGGUILLI: Then, the second matter is another conflict situation.

The Town had denied a claim by a non-resident for damage to a vehicle for a pothole. The gentleman is a retired State Trooper who I happen to know very well personally. I was actually best man at his wedding. I am therefore conflicted out.

When one attorney in a law office has a conflict, all of the attorneys in the office have the conflict. So, I would request a vote either one, given the nature of the amount of the underlying claim being \$750.69 - - the Town Board may consider that it would be more beneficial to merely pay the claim rather than to hire outside counsel which could be more expensive and most likely would be. I'm just looking for some direction at this point.

MR. GREEN: Michael, after having heard it upstairs, I think it is more cost-effective to pay that amount knowing that an attorney on the outside may charge us more to prepare and handle it.

I'm going to make that motion to go ahead and pay that \$750.69 claim, in lieu of appointing anyone outside to represent us.

Apparently it was denied and 7 a small claim was filed which requires us to act. In the 10 or 11 years that I have been here, this is the first time something like this has happened. 9 10 MS. WHALEN: Mike, I assume that you probably 11 don't have that many friends that this would become a dangerous precedent to set. So, I will vote for it in 12 this one instance. Hopefully your friends don't come out 13 of the woodwork hitting potholes or we will be setting a 14 15 very dangerous precedent which I will not vote for this 16 again. Because of the dollar amount of the claim, it 17 does make fiscal sense in this instance. I vote yes. 18 MS. GANSLE: It has been moved and seconded. 19 SUPERVISOR MAHAN: Supervisor votes aye.
