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MS. GANSLE: This public hearing is being held by order of the Town Board for the purpose of receiving comments from the public on the proposed public housing plan for the 2020 Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program. Notice of such issue has been published in the official Town newspaper which is the Spotlight and has been posted on the Town Clerk's bulletin board. I have an affidavit for each. The Town Board will now hear all persons interested in this proposal.

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MR. MASTRIANNI: Good evening. My name is Jim Mastrianni. My company is Joseph E. Mastrianni, Incorporated, JEM, Inc. for short. Our organization administers housing choice options programs on behalf of municipalities like yourself and we do this in nine counties helping more than 3,000 families.

This is the 40th year that we have administered the Town's Housing Choice Voucher Program. For just a quick refresher the HCV, Housing Choice Voucher Program helps our elderly and our low income families to afford safe, sanitary decent housing that is done by providing a subsidy. This program is fully funded by the Federal Housing and Urban Development and an estimate of the funding this year is \$2.7 million dollars. It lets us help 350 families per year.

1	So, the reason that we are here tonight is we
2	have to allow for public comment on a plan. We do this
3	plan every five years. The plan is - what it boils
4	down to is that it comes down to a handful of goals.
5	Those goals are: We are going to expand the supply of
6	assisted housing in the community. We are going to
7	improve the quality of service that we deliver. We are
8	going to promote self-sufficiency and asset
9	development of families and individuals. We are going
10	to ensure equal opportunity in housing and we're going
11	to reduce fraud and program abuse.
12	My personal opinion is that this is a very
13	important program because we know that if you have
14	stable housing, you are able to achieve positive
15	outcomes in life. This helps the most vulnerable
16	members of our community achieve stable housing.
