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MS. GANSLE: This public hearings being held by order of the Town Board pursuant to Section 202 of the Town Law to hear all persons in relation to the annual estimate of construction expense of improvements and benefit assessment roll for the Town of Colonie Sewer Improvement Area. Notice of the public hearing has been published in the Town newspaper which is the Spotlight and has been posted on the Town Clerk's bulletin board. I have an affidavit for each.

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The Town Board will now hear all persons interested in this matter.

MS. PECK: Good evening. My name is Crystal

Peck and I serve as special district counsel for the

Town of Colonie. The Town of Colonie Sewer Improvement

Area is comprised of all parcels within the boundaries

of the Town and is classified as a special district

under the General Municipal Law. It receives revenue for

operating and debt service expenses by assessing all of

the parcels within the district based on sewer benefit.

Pursuant to section 202 of the State of New
York Town Laws, the Town of Colonie's Assessors Office
has assessed all parcels of land within the Colonie
Sewer Improvement Area based on a benefit assessment.
The 2019 sewer benefit assessment roll is available
for review in the Assessor's Office for the public.

Section 202 provides that the assessment against all parcels within the Colonie Sewer Improvement Area before the annual estimate of expense of constructing the sewers, the sewers disposal plants and drainage systems and constructing laterals within the Colonie Sewer Iprovement Area. The assessment against the parcels is divided into two categories of benefits called units.

The first category of unit is termed a units which are assessed against properties that have sewer available to them. The number of a units is determined by the annual water usage of the property along with the parcel size.

The second category are D units. They are assessed against properties that do not have sewer service. The number of D units is determined by the parcel size. There were 181,878 A units and 59,531 D units assessed against properties on the 2019 sewer benefit assessment roll. Based on the division of Pure Waters proposed 2020 debt service budget of \$3,982,740.67, the charge for in a unit will increase by \$1.17 from the 2019 rate of \$20.70 to \$21.87 per unit.

The D unit remains the same at \$.10 per unit.

Based on the 2020 unit points and rates and average
