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Notice of the public hearing has been published in the official Town newspaper which is the Spotlight and has been posted in the Town Clerk's bulletin board. I have an affidavit for each.

MS. PECK: The project before the Board tonight relates to the pipe bridge evaluation project. The Division of Pure Waters owns and operates five sanitary sewer bridges throughout the Town. Recently, inspections were conducted to evaluate the structural integrity of each pipe bridge. Certain repairs and preemptive measures were identified for each pipe and have been detailed in the engineering report prepared by Greenman Pedersen, which is on file with the Town Clerk's office. Those recommendations are also itemized in the Resolution that is before the Town Board tonight.

The maximum amount to complete the recommended repairs and preemptive measures is \$1,759,000. It is estimated that the project will be bonded over a 30-year timeframe and it would result in

1	an increase of \$2.45 in the annual sewer charges
2	assessed against a typical single-family residential
