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MS. GANSLE: This public hearing is being held by order of the Town Board pursuant to Section 202B of the Town Law of the State of New York in relation to the proposed River Road storage and Mohawk View Water Treatment Plant mixing study. A report was prepared by O'Brien and Geer Engineers Inc. in relation to the proposed project and has been on file in the Town Clerk's office.

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Notice of this public hearing has been published in the official Town newspaper which is the Spotlight in has been posted on the Town Clerk's bulletin board. I have an affidavit for each. The Town Board will now hear all persons interested in this project.

MS. PECK: The project before the Board is to approve improvements and repairs that were recommended in the River Road Storage and Mohawk View Water Treatment Plant mixing study. The water treatment plant was originally constructed in 1969 and was expanded in 2005. It reduces all the water used within the Latham Water service area.

The Town obtained the engineering services of O'Brien and Geer to evaluate the capability of the existing facilities to convey water from the treatment plant to water storage tanks at the River Road site to

evaluate storage requirements at the River Road site into evaluate potential improvements to chemical mixing at the treatment plant.

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As a result of the study, there have been recommendations for repair and improvements which include demolishing two of the existing water storage tanks and replacing it with one larger storage tank; rehabilitation and improvements to altitude valves in valve vaults at the site of the River Road high lift pump station; improvements to the high-pressure interconnection to the 30-inch finished water pipeline that leads from the River Road site to the treatment plant; modifications to the inlet piping at the back pumping station and replacements of several valves in the distribution system behind the pump station at Route 7 and modifications to buildings number one through six piping in the treatment plant.

The maximum amount proposed for this project is \$6,050,000. It is a capital project which means that it will be assessed against the properties within the Latham Water district on an ad valorem basis. It is assumed that the project will be bonded with a 20-year bond at a 3% interest rate and level repayment schedule. The new debt service is expected to increase the districts special ad valorem tax rate by

1 approximately \$10.79 per year for a typical 2 single-family home. This project is an unlisted project under the 3 New York State Environmental Quality Eeview Act. A 4 short form environmental assessment form has been 5 provided by the Town's engineer which shows the 7 project will not have a significant impact on the environment and as such no further determination or procedure will be required under the state 9 Environmental Quality Review Act. 10 11 The engineer for the project is available 12 tonight in case the Board or the public have any questions about the particulars of the project. 13 14 SUPERVISOR MAHAN: Are there any further 15 questions from the Board? 16 (There was no response.) 17 Any questions from the audience. 18 (There was no response.) 19 We will close the public hearing. 2.0 MS.
