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MS. GANSLE: This public hearing is being held by order of the Town Board pursuant to Article 12 a of the State of New York Town Law in connection with the proposed 21 Green Mountain Drive Sanitary Sewer Improvement Area #2019-003.

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Notice of the public hearing has been published in the official Town newspaper which is the Spotlight and has been posted on the Town Clerk's bulletin board. I have an affidavit for each. The Town Board will now hear all persons interested in this project.

MR. BAILEY: Good evening. My name is

Ryan Bailey from the law firm of Bailey

Johnson and Peck. We are the counsel for the water district and the sewer district. I am here to present on this project tonight.

The applicant for this project is ABF Freight. The location is 21 Green Mountain Drive. It's currently being operated as a trucking terminal. It has on-site sewer treatment and the applicant is proposing to connect to the source system.

The applicant will construct a new force main sewer for dedication to the Town. The new

sewer consists of 435 lineal feet of piping and a force main flushing manhole at the intersection of Green Mountain Drive and Arrowhead Lane. The total cost of the project is \$17,872. The applicant will be responsible for financing the entirety of the project.

The current annual user charge is \$287.39 and this will be billed directly to the applicant.

Dan Hershberg of Hershberg and Hershberg is here this evening. He is the engineer on the project if anyone has any questions.

SUPERVISOR MAHAN: Does anyone from the Board have any questions?
