medical first responders to improve all
quality of care for the elevation myocardial
infraction patient by directly influencing the
Stem I system of care.

This is not the first time that EMS has received this award.

MR. KOSTYUN: This is the second for this award. It is a gradual thing where based on our performance, you are eligible for the next year. It is the highest version of the award. I just wanted to thank these guys and gals for this award.
