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MS. GANSLE: This public hearing is being held by order of the Town Board pursuant to Section 202A of the Town Law to hear all persons in relation to the annual estimate of expense of maintenance and benefit assessment role for the Town of Colonie sewer improvement area. Notice the public hearing has been published in the official Town newspaper which is the Spotlight and has been posted on the Town Clerk's bulletin board. I have an affidavit for each. The Town Board will now hear all persons interested in this matter.

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MS. PECK: Good evening, my name is
Crystal Peck. I'm an attorney that serves as
special district council for the Town of
Colonie.

The Town of Colonie sewer improvement area is comprised of all parcels within the boundaries of the Town and is classified as a special district and under General Municipal Law receives revenue for operating and debt service expenses by assessing all of the parcels within the district based on a sewer benefit.

Pursuant to Section 202 of the State of
New York Town Law, the Town of Colonie
Assessor's office has assessed all parcels of
land within the Colonie sewer improvement area
based upon a benefit assessment. The 2020
sewer benefit assessment roll is available on
the Town's website.

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Section 202 A of the Town Law of the State of New York provides assessment against all parcels within the Colonie sewer improvement area for the annual estimate of expense of operation and maintenance costs. Points are assessed against all parcels within the Colonie sewer improvement area that are connected to a public sewer system. The number of points is determined by the annual water usage of the property. Residential properties are assessed three points for each living unit and commercial properties are assessed one point for each 27,000 gallons of water used in a 12-month period with a minimum assessment of three points. There are 112,657 points assessed against properties on the 2020 benefit assessment roll. Based upon the division of Pure Waters proposed 2020

operating and maintenance budget of \$6,697,225.98, the point charge will increase by \$2.49 from the 2020 rate per point. Based on the 2021 unit end point rates, an average single-family residential home will be assessed \$298.90 and a two-family home will be assessed \$552.45 in the annual sewer usage charges.
