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MS. GANSLE: This public hearing is being held by order of the Town Board pursuant to Section 202 of the Town Law to hear all persons in relation to the annual estimate of construction expense of improvements and benefit assessment role for the Town of Colonie sewer improvement area. Notice of this public hearing has been published in the official Town newspaper which is the Spotlight and has been posted on the Town Clerk's bulletin board. I have an affidavit for each. The Town Board will not hear all persons interested in this matter.

MS. PECK: Section 202 of the Town Law of the State of New York provides assessment against all parcels within the Colonie sewer improvement area for annual estimate of expense of constructing sewers, sewage disposal plants and drainage systems and constructing laterals within the Colonie sewer improvement area.

The assessment against the parcels is divided into two categories of benefits called units. The first category of unit is termed A units which are assessed against properties

that have sewer available. The number of A units is determined by the annual water usage of the property and parcel size.

The second category is D units which are assessed against properties that do not have sewer service. The number of D units is determined by parcel size. There were 181,814 A units and 58,886 D units assessed against properties in the 2020 sewer benefit assessment role. Based on the Division of Pure Waters' proposed 2021 debt service budget of \$4,128,081.97, the charge for an A unit will increase by \$0.80 from the 2020 rate and a D unit will remain the same at \$0.10 per unit. Based on the 2020 unit rates, and average single-family residential home will be assessed \$298.90 and a two-family home will be assessed \$552.45 in annual sewer usage charges.
