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MR. MAGGUILLI: We have a number of personnel matters on tonight.

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First is permanently appointing Jill Lieberman to the position of Typist, Grade 6, in the DPW/Division of Latham Water; \$33,265 and she starts December 7th.

Resolution 418B is provisionally appointing Robert Diamond to the position of Water Meter Service Worker, Grade 9, in the DPW/Division of Latham Water; \$25.69 an hour effective November 23, 2020, pending the establishment of an appropriate eligible list.

Resolution 418C is appointing Chris
Comproski to Laborer, Grade 7, in the
DPW/Division of Latham Water; \$19.00 an hour
effective December 7th, pending satisfactory
completion of a pre-employment physical.

Resolution 418D is provisionally appointing David Dupuis to the position of Water Treatment Plant Maintenance Mechanic, Grade 25, in Latham Water at an annual salary of \$57,950, effective December 7th, pending the establishment of an appropriate eligible list.

Next we are reinstating Katelyn Connelly

to the position of Senior Resource Caseworker, Grade 11, in the Senior Resources Department starting November 16th.

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Lastly, we have Jessica Loveland, Library Clerk to take leave without pay. She has some personal issues to take care of. This will be from November 13th through December 31, 2020.

Resolution 419 is authorizing expenditure of funds from the insurance reserve fund for payment of legal fees, expenses and/or settlement in connection with litigation. This is for the cases listed here; Clough Harbour & Associates for the Fusco case. That's the case where he had the landslide and he claims it's the Town's fault. That's at \$330.00.

Then, there is Cooper Erving & Savage, also for the Fusco case.

Also, Niedbalec, McMillan, Falace and Geraci; \$8,710.11.

MS. MURPHY: Which one is Falace?

MR. MAGGUILLI: That's the one with the Justice Court and the demands for information that they were requesting that they claim were not timely.

We have another matter in that case to

discuss.

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MR. GREEN: We can call and Executive Session for that?

MR. MAGGUILLI: Yes.

These next three are all identical. They are for the various Fire Departments and amending the Service Award Program for active volunteer firefighter members. This is for Fuller Road, Shaker Road, and Maplewood. This is at no cost to the Town.

Next we have a Resolution appointing

Martin Robinson as a member to the Town of

Colonie Conservation Advisory Council. He will

be filling the vacancy of Donald Allard for

the rest of his term expiring December 31,

2021. I'm not sure what the salary is. It's

not much for those folks.

MR. GREEN: It's like \$3,000 or something.

MR. MAGGUILLI: Next we have a Resolution authorizing settlement or discontinuance of a cert cases. This is for 442 Broadway. Total tentative Town refund is \$4,169.80 and school refund of \$30,796.31. These are set forth in Exhibit A.

Next we are authorizing Paula to reimburse for overestimated water usage for Allen Johnson, Jr. of 36 Oakwood Drive; \$3,570.65 and Christopher Hansen at 2 Bosher Drive for \$5,309.31. We thank them for the interest fee loan.

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Next we have a Resolution authorizing the Supervisor to execute a Professional Service Agreement with C.T. Male Associates in connection with the 169th Extension engineer's report. This is at a cost not to exceed \$2,800.00.

Resolution 427 is Resolution authorizing Paula to enter into an Agreement with Brycer Company, LLC in connection with tracking third-party inspections of code required life safety devices.

Anything you want to add to that, Chris? MR. KOSTYUN: No, that's about it.

MR. MAGGUILLI: Resolution 428 is authorizing Paula to enter into an Agreement with Absolute Seamless Gutters in connection with the installation of gutters at the Municipal Training Building. This is at a cost not to exceed \$1,000.00 and the

agreement is subject to the review and approval of my office.

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For the next Resolution, I'd like to ask for a motion to adjourn this to the next meeting. I have questions that I haven't gotten answered yet. I need to speak with Dick Comey and I just haven't been able to get him. I know that Dave Brennan will be here tonight, but I still have questions and I need them answered.

MS. GANSLE: Do you want to adjourn that here or -

MR. MAGGUILLI: We'll do it downstairs.

MR. GREEN: I'd like to make a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss litigation matters with the Town.

SUPERVISOR MAHAN: And Chris and Nancy and Mike and Julie to stay.

MS. MURPHY: Second.

MS. GANSLE: All those in favor?
