1 MS. GANSLE: This public hearing is being held
2 by order of the Town Board to hear all persons in
3 relation to the proposed Safety-Kleen sanitary sewer
4 extension project number 2019 - 002.

5 A report was published by CT Male Associates
6 in relation to the proposed project and has been on
7 file in the Town Clerk's office. Notice of the public
8 hearing has been published in the official Town
9 newspaper which is the Spotlight and has been posted
10 on the Town Clerk's bulletin board. I have an
11 affidavit for each. The Town Board will now hear all
12 persons interested in this project.

13 MS. PECK: Good evening my name is Crystal Peck
14 and I am an attorney with Bailey Johnson and Peck. We
15 serve as special district counsel for the Town of
16 Colonie.

17 The project before the Board tonight is to
18 extend municipal sanitary sewer service to the
19 existing office and warehouse site of the Safety-Kleen
20 Corporation which is located at 17 Green Mountain
21 Drive in the Town of Colonie. The project will include
22 construction of 215 lineal feet of force main sanitary
23 sewer pipe in 173 lineal feet of sanitary sewer
24 lateral. The total project cost will be \$15,943 which
25 will be paid entirely by the owner of the property.

1 The permit fee for this project will be \$575 plus \$12
2 per fixture above 20 units and paid for entirely by
3 the property owner, as well. *The engineer for the
4 project is here tonight if the Board or the public
5 have any questions.

6 SUPERVISOR MAHAN: Are there any further
